

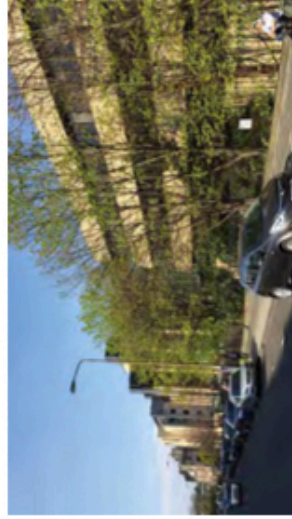
INTRODUCTION

Welcome to this public consultation exhibition relating to proposals by the Royal Bank of Scotland (RBS) to redevelop land within its ownership at Dundas Street/Fettes Row/Eyre Terrace, Edinburgh

RBS has recently announced plans to close its existing offices at Dundas Street/Fettes Row and relocate its staff to its headquarters at Gogarburn, Edinburgh. Following the closure of the offices, it is RBS' intention that the site is redeveloped for residential led mixed uses.

This is the second in a series of consultation events which are taking place to inform the proposals for the site. It is taking place in advance of the submission of an Application for Planning Permission in Principle to the City of Edinburgh Council.

Today's event sets out the feedback we received from the 1st public consultation event in September and presents some initial development options for the site, including a preferred development option. At this event, we are seeking your feedback on these options.
